Construction of the Chiloquin Elementary School Playground renovation project will begin soon! The playground will also serve as a community park, when CES students are not in session.

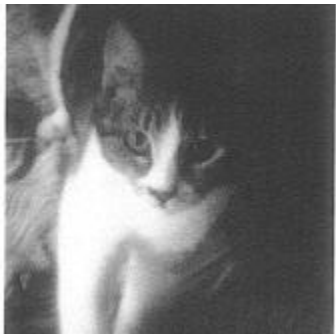
